

Learning QuarkXPress

Word processor

- software primarily focuses on inputting & formatting text for general print uses (reports, letters, etc.)
- generally includes
 limited graphics
 capabilities

Unit One: Ovrvw of the Post Modern Era/Short Stories (5 weeks)



Key Concepts

- **QXP** is a box-based environment (text must be placed in a text box, graphics must be placed in a picture box.)
- ITEM tool vs. CONTENT tool
- can enter text in **QXP** or import from other word processing programs
- can import graphics of various formats

Formatting text & graphics

fine tuning elements in your document

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Formatting text & graphics

- enlarging & reducing images (MODIFY)
- can format text characteristics like a word processor (font, size, style, color)
- use palettes for quick control (remember they are context sensitive!)
- changing numbers of columns & gutter widths (MODIFY)
